1. Discussion with Jan Kiehl, City of Thornton, about our participation in the 50th Anniversary and Fourth of July celebration. Goal is to get 50 Veterans from each branch of the service to stand in a representation of the Veteran's Memorial wearing colored shirts. Each point of the star would have a different colored shirt.
 - A. Also sell lighted flag pins and maybe receive part of the proceeds.
 - B. Need a place to sell shirts. TVMF must supply canopy, table and chairs.
 - C. Advertising to be placed in the Thornton Summer Quarterly, The Hub, and The Sentinel.
 - D. Pictures of Veterans and their names on the jumbotron.
 - E. Draft letters to businesses for sponsorship.
2. We need to decide by June if we are going to have a Veteran's Day Ceremony so it can make it into the Thornton Fall Quarterly. Deadline for quarterly is July.
 - A. Have a float in the Denver parade to advertise memorial. Bob Heller will check on how to sign up for the parade.
 - B. Banner across Washington Street advertising event.
 - C. Have a breakfast.
3. Chameleon Ways natural aggregate bound surfaces is willing to come speak with up about their product.
4. Golden Hall of Fame is part of the 50th Anniversary and honors people who have made a contribution to the city. It is not limited to those who are still alive.
5. Kris said they were meeting with city about the tank and antenna design. Overall park design should be submitted to the city in the next 3-4 weeks. A meeting with the City Council will most likely be done at some point and we should be involved with that. Tank design is to be completed by June 2006, construction to start in late summer 2006, and completed in spring 2007.
